## Remembering Ted

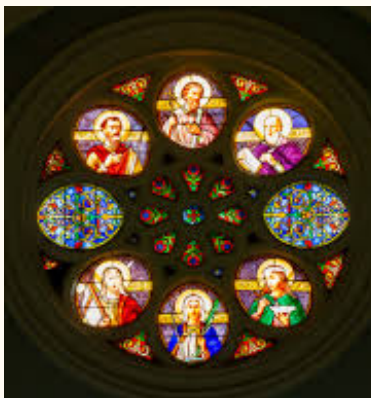

## Forest School Review

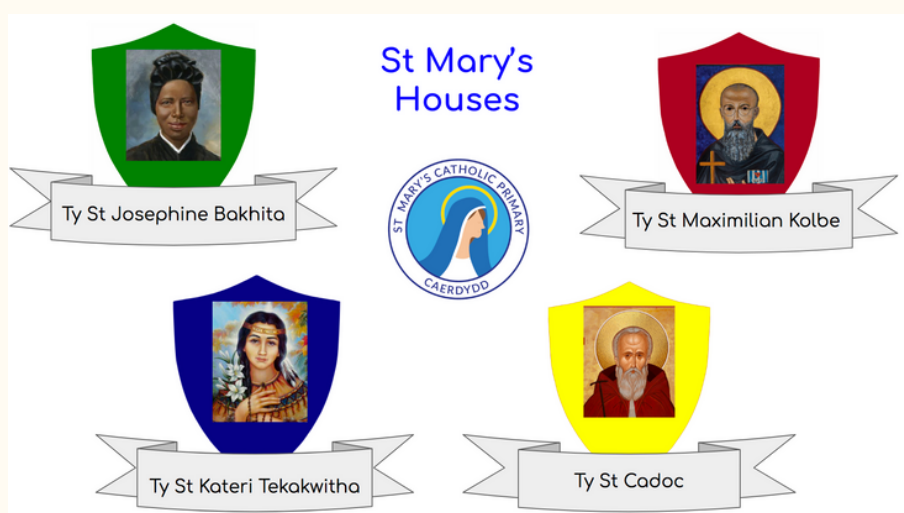
Last half term, each class enjoyed a day of forest school. The new tightropes and hammocks were thoroughly enjoyed!
