Our history topic for this half-term was toys. At the start of our topic, we created a physical timeline and discussed toys we play with now and how these are different to when we were a baby and toddler.



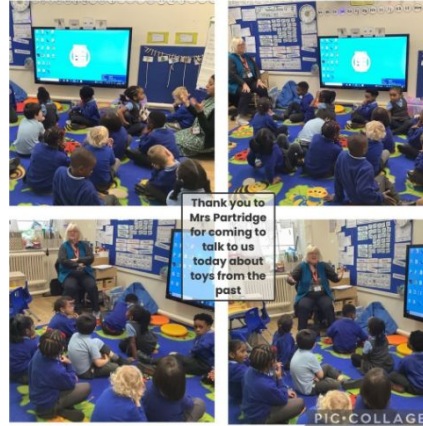
We developed our oracy and listening skills by sharing our favourite toys with our friends, thinking about what makes them special to us and the materials they are made from.
